Black Violin artists Kev Marcus and Wil-B have created the ultimate synergy between classical and Hip-Hop music, and with it, an incredible opportunity to reach young children. Together with their DJ, they are passionate about making sure that America’s young people have exposure to the arts as they themselves did in their youth.

They kick off the student matinee with a performance followed by an in-depth exploration about which songs were recognized during the performance (both hip-hop, classical), what opinions students had about the music, which different styles meshed effectively and sound harmonious, and which were jarring and discordant, and exploring and comparing the performance to traditional classical music concerts and what were similarities and differences.

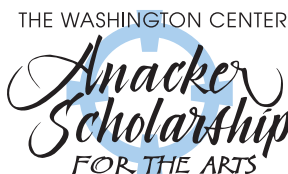
